

Volunteer Opportunities at The People's Legal Center



The People's Legal Center is seeking energetic, motivated volunteers to work as part of our team. Our goal is to establish legal help for low-income residents of the Ocean View, Ingleside/Lakeview, and Excelsior districts of San Francisco. As part of the team, you will gain valuable experience as part of a non-profit legal assistance / legal education center, develop skills, make contacts, gain valuable references, and more. Here we describe some of the volunteer opportunities at The People's Legal Center:

Community Outreach Volunteers

We are initiating a legal needs survey of residents of the Ocean View, Ingleside/Lakeview, and Excelsior districts of San Francisco. Community Outreach Volunteers are needed to help conduct the survey at various sites. We are looking for friendly people who can speak comfortably with survey participants. Volunteers who speak Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, and Tagalog are especially needed.

Adult Legal Education Volunteers

We are conducting basic legal education seminars for adults at community centers in the Ocean View, Ingleside/Lakeview, and Excelsior districts of San Francisco. Adult Legal Education Volunteers are needed to help prepare materials, teach classes, and provide translation to low-income adults.

K-12 Civics Education Volunteers

We are working with California On My Honor (<http://www.courtinfo.ca.gov/reference/cift.htm>) to bring civics education to K-12 students in San Francisco. K-12 Civics Education Volunteers are needed to help with curriculum development and assist in teaching K-12 classes.

Volunteer Interns

To carry out the key functions of The People's Legal Center, we are seeking interns. The Volunteer Interns will work with the Executive Director to build, improve, and operate our programs.
